

TERM 2 UPDATE: Tuesday 28th April 2020

Dear Safety Bay families,

Firstly, I would like to thank all families for completing our form sent out last week. This information has been vital in helping us plan so we can keep your children and our staff safe during this time. This letter is to provide you with some more detail on how Weeks 1-3 of Term 2 will work for students attending school or learning from home.

The State Government has now given you the choice to either send your child back to school or continue to have them learn at home. I understand this may be an uncertain and difficult period for you and your family and I support the decisions that you as parents and carers are making for your children and families. Arrangements for Weeks 1-3 for students attending school:

- From Wednesday 28th April (first day of Term 2) students attending school will be on their normal timetable;
- **Year 11 and 12 students are strongly encouraged to attend school to continue their critical study program;**
- **The CANTEEN IS CLOSED Week 1, so please bring your own lunch & refillable water bottle;**
- The onsite Tudor Uniforms Shop will remain closed, online ordering is available from their website: <http://www.tudorschooluniforms.com.au/>

Special arrangements to keep your children safe at school:

- The Oval, Admin and Bike Rack gates will be open from 8-8:30am, with students required to utilise the hand sanitiser available as they enter school;
- Parents please drop your child/children at the drop off zone, and do not enter the school grounds;
- If you need to pick up/drop off your child during school hours please call us on 9527 0200, then select Option 1 to speak to Student Services;
- Desks/students will be separated as much as possible in classrooms;
- Hand sanitiser and tissues will be available in all classrooms;
- Desks & other high touch areas will be cleaned 2-3 times a day;
- Classroom doors will remain open to minimise the amount of people touching door handles;
- Please keep your children home if they show any signs of illness

Arrangements for Weeks 1-3 for students learning at home:

- For those children learning from home, this will be online through **Connect**;
- Details of how to undertake and return the work will be provided;
- Prior arrangements made regarding work packages will continue;
- For those students who are learning from home, contact by school will be made each week by phone and/or online;

These arrangements will remain in place until the end of Week 3, and will then be **reviewed ahead of Week 4 commencing 18 May**. State Government and school decisions will be based on the best health advice. We want all families and children to feel supported and informed during this time. I thank you for your partnership as we navigate this together.
