## What Contributions and Charges Pay For

#### **VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION**

Up to \$235 a year per student in Years 7-10, this pays for subject costs including: Books, Sporting equipment, Arts materials, Science equipment

#### **COMPULSORY CHARGES**

Cover payments for additional resources for elective subjects in Lower School and all subjects in Senior School. These are due in full before the end of Term 1 2022.

#### **VOLUNTARY APPROVED REQUESTS**

You can choose to contribute to the following: Building Fund (tax deductible), Chaplain Fund, Mental Health & Wellbeing Initiatives (provided by Student Services).

#### **OTHER OPTIONAL COSTS**

Including the Year 7-9 Health Workbooks (\$20) and the Year 7-10 MathsOnline Subscription (\$10).

### **Financial Assistance**

#### **SECONDARY ASSISTANCE SCHEME (SAS)**

Secondary Assistance in the form of financial subsidies is available to holders of valid Centrelink Health Care Cards, Pensioner Concession Cards or Veterans Affairs Concession Cards. This entitles the cardholder to \$235 towards Voluntary Contribution and an additional \$115 Uniform Allowance. The Education Program Allowance (\$235) is paid directly to the school and applied to Voluntary Contributions for Years 7-10. For those parents/guardians who elect to direct their Uniform Allowance (\$115) to the school, these funds will be deducted from the compulsory charges first and then voluntary contributions (Years 7-10). For eligible students in Years 11 and 12, both Education Program Allowance and Uniform Allowance will be applied directly to compulsory charges. Application forms are available through our Accounts Officer. Students or parents need to provide proof of eligibility and the Accounts Officer needs to witness the application form. Applications must be completed in Term 1 each school year.

#### WANSLEA GRANDCARERS SCHEME

The WANSLEA Grandcarers Support Scheme is an annual payment to grandparents who have the full-time care of their grandchildren. Call 1800 794 909 between 10.00am and 4.00pm Monday to Friday for more information.

#### **SAVERPLUS**

Developed by ANZ and the Brotherhood of St Laurence, SaverPlus is delivered across Kwinana and Rockingham by the Smith Family. You may be eligible if you have a Health Care or Pensioner Concession Card, are at least 18 years old, have regular income from work, and have a child at school or study yourself.
